SAFETY TIPS FOR VISITORS



AT THE AIRPORT

- Always keep your luggage and documents close to you. Do not display valuables or use your cell at taxis or transfers stops. Avoid crowds as it can mean an opportunity for pickpockets.
- For the transfer to the hotel, take official services for tourists. Avoid unofficial taxis or transfers.



TRANSFER TO YOUR HOTEL

- Official transfers or taxi drivers should be alert if a motorcycle or car is following the car. If that happens, call Carabineros (133).
- Make sure the driver leaves you at your hotel entrance. If there is underground parking, prefer to be left inside.
- Only an identified hotel bellman can take your baggage.



AT THE HOTEL

- Always stay with your baggage. If you walk into the lobby, ahead of your luggage, a thief can take advantage of your distraction.
- Keep all valuables you will not carry with you in the safe. It is also advisable to leave your passport in the safe and leave the hotel with a photocopy or photo of it.
- If you lose your key or room entry card, report it to the hotel immediately and ask to be moved to another room. You can't assume you "lost it", it may have been stolen from you by someone with malicious intent.



SHARED HOSTING

- If you made reservations through platforms such as Airbnb or Booking, be sure to verify if the address is real. Always check comments.



WHEN YOU ARE OUT

- Don't flaunt expensive jewelry, watch, camera smartphone or cash in public.
- Do not use your cell phone on the street, as you will not be aware of your surroundings. Use it in closed spaces and, if necessary, use hands-free with the cell phone stored in your purse or pocket.
- During the day, avoid walking in unknown and deserted spots. At night try not to walk alone and prefer the busiest and brightest routes. Remain constantly alert.
- Avoid taking taxis in public places. Ask the hotel for an official taxi contact number. When you take a taxi, make sure the vehicle has the meter running and in a visible place.
- Never lose sight of your belongings in restaurants, cafes or bars.
